Diverse driving forces, processes and actors are responsible for different trends in the development of megacities and large urban areas. an ancient institution in Eastern Polynesia called the rahui, a form of restricting access to resources and/or territories. While tapu had been extensively discussed in the scientific literature on Oceanian anthropology, the rahui is quite absent from secondary modern literature.
