In his discussion of
clowns in nineteenth-
century French
painting from Jean-
Léon Gérôme's 1857
*La Sortie du bal
masqué* to Georges
Rouault, art historian
Francis Haskell
wondered why they are
so sad. The myth of the
sad clown as an
allegory for the
unappreciated artist
found echoes in the
work of literary
counterparts like
Charles Baudelaire and
his "Vieux
saltimbanque" who
seeks in vain a
responsive public. For
some, the attraction of
the acrobatic clown for
the creative
imagination may have
been his ability to
embody the plight of
the artist: these

artists generally led
an ambulatory and
uncertain existence.
Other artists and
writers, however,
particularly the
Decadents, perceived
in the circus acrobat -
including the acrobatic
clown - a conceptual
and performative tool
for liberating their
points of view from the
prison-house of
aesthetic convention. If
authors' protagonists
were themselves
sometimes failures,
their aesthetic
innovations often
produced exhilarating
artistic triumphs.
Among the works
examined in this study
are the circus posters
of Jules Chéret,
Thomas Couture's
Pierrot and *Harlequin*
paintings, Honoré
Daumier's
saltimbanque
paintings, Edgar

Degas's Miss Lala au Cirque Fernando, Édouard Manet's Un bar au Folies-Bergère, the pantomimes of the Hanlon-Lees troupe, and novels, short stories, and poems by Théodore de Banville, Edmond de Goncourt, J. K. Huysmans, Gustave Kahn, Jules Laforgue, Catulle Mendès, Octave Mirbeau, Jean Richepin, Edouard Rod, and Marcel Schwob. Author-title Catalogue V&R Unipress

 Les Contes cruels paraissent en 1883. Cinq ans plus tard, les Nouveaux Contes cruels ajoutent huit récits à cet ensemble placé sous le signe de la cruauté. Si l'on en croit Villiers, ces «contes terribles» ont été écrits d'après l'esthétique d'Edgar Poe. La facture impeccable, la fulgurance des effets, la construction «désespérément logique» : voilà les traits qui les apparentent aux Histoires extraordinaires. Mais il ne faut pas exagérer ce rapprochement :

Villiers, qui donne ainsi ses lettres de noblesse à la nouvelle moderne, renouvelle le topos de la cruauté en littérature, en inventant une manière inusitée de faire mal au lecteur.

This book investigates the space between the two languages of modern-day Brittany through a series of close readings of literary texts that represent Brittany or Bretonness in the French language. This is the space that is negotiated by translation, be it a smooth translation of Breton scenes and

themes into a French fit for the salons of the capital, or a foreignizing translation of Breton motifs into a French that writhes and struggles to accommodate them. It is also the space negotiated by the bilingual author who writes in the shadow of the other language: the literary conventions of one may litter his work in the other, or the idioms and syntax of one may make their ghostly presence felt in the other. But it can equally be a space of violence as in the case of the writer whose whole community has lost its mother tongue, and writes under protest in the language of the cultural oppressor or colonizer. As the first sustained analysis of the

literature produced between French and Breton, this book shows us how literary language is affected by such inter-cultural tensions, and also what it can mean to be caught between cultures.

 Die Französische Republik, das sind Marianne auf der einen Seite, die Gemeinschaft der gleichen Brüder auf der anderen – und die unsagbare Vorstellung eines entmannten Staats dazwischen. Der neue politische Körper ist alles andere als

eindeutig und so sind es auch die Texte der Dritten Republik nicht, die an seiner Repräsentation arbeiten. Ausgehend von der Erzählung einer Identität in der Krise bieten Huysmans, Zola, Lorrain oder Barrès verschiedene Lösungen des Konflikts zwischen einer Ideologie des virilen Bruderbunds und einem Imaginären der verlorenen Männlichkeit an. Jarry, Romain und Proust reagieren auf diese Lösungen, dekonstruieren sie oder stellen ihre Widersprüche aus. In zahlreichen Einzelanalysen wird so ein Panorama von Formen der Arbeit am und mit dem Allegorischen präsentiert.
