The incomparable poetry of Han Shan (Cold Mountain) and his sidekick Shih Te, the rebel poets who became icons of Chinese poetry and Zen, has long captured the imagination of poetry lovers and Zen aficionados. Popularized in the West by Beat Generation writers Gary Snyder and Jack Kerouac, these legendary T'ang era (618-907) figures are portrayed as the laughing, ragged pair who left their poetry on stones, trees, farmhouses, and the walls of the monasteries they visited.

Their poetry expressed in the simplest verse but in a completely new tone, the voice of ordinary people. Here premier translator J. P. Seaton takes a fresh look at these captivating poets, along with Wang Fan-chih, another "outsider" poet who lived a couple centuries later and who captured the poverty and gritty day-to-day reality of the common people of his time. Wilhelm Raabe's novel entitled *Der Hungerpastor* (1864) is a classic example of the so-called "poetic realism" to which many - primarily bourgeois - German writers were devoted between 1850 and 1890. --- Wilhelm Raabe (1831 - 1910) became famous following the publication of his first novel, *Die Chronik der Sperlingsgasse* (The Sparrow Lane Chronicle), in 1856. His late works are known for their social criticism, while earlier novels, such as *The Hunger Pastor*, were intended to be primarily educational. --- With the figure of Hans Unwirrsch in *The Hunger Pastor*, Raabe completely lives up to his motto - "Look up to the stars. Pay attention to the streets." The budding

pastor, who was born into poverty, "hungers" for knowledge and a respected place in society, but he constantly stumbles over obstacles that his own life, as well as the lives of his family and friends, place before him. --- Raabe's rambling style makes his works difficult reading for many contemporary readers. In this version of *The Hunger Pastor*, several chapters have therefore been summarized by the translator, while the most important ones are published in their original length. --- Despite some anti-Semitic elements, which were commonly found in the works of some 19th century bourgeois writers in Germany, *The Hunger Pastor* is and remains a German literature classic.

Parallels between Hittite civilisation and the Old Testament belong largely to the field of religion. In the first of his three Schweich lectures (delivered in 1976) Professor Gurney traces the historical development of the Hittite pantheon, while in his second and third lectures he selects some aspects of Hittite religion which can be compared with ancient Hebrew and Canaanite institutions. The second lecture describes the cult, both local and official, and the purpose of the open-air temple at Yazilikaya. The third is devoted to Hittite rituals of elimination and substitution and the mortuary ritual for the King. Parallels are drawn with the biblical masseba as a cult object and with the scapegoat ritual of Leviticus.

Roland M. Lehmann untersucht zunächst die Entwicklung Luthers als Prediger bis 1518 und konzentriert sich dann auf die Predigten, die der Reformator ausserhalb Wittenbergs hielt. Von den 99 erhaltenen Reisepredigten werden 45 hinsichtlich ihrer Überlieferungsgeschichtlichen, agendarischen, historischen und theologischen Kontexte analysiert und deren Inhalte rekonstruiert. Dabei treten die vielseitigen Facetten seiner Kanzeltätigkeit hervor: Luther als Streitprediger, Missionarsprediger, Umlandsprediger, Hofprediger und weitere mehr. Einige Urteile der Weimarer Ausgabe werden dabei revidiert. So bezweifelt der Autor die gängige Forschungsmeinung, Luthers letztes Kanzelwort sei die "Vermahnung wider die Juden" gewesen. Überdies wird beschrieben, wie aus einer knappen Predigtmitschrift ein umfangreiches Druckwerk entsteht. Bislang in der Forschung kaum berücksichtigt sind Luthers Kasualpredigten, auf die der Verfasser ausführlich eingeht.

Based on a year-long micro-ethnography of a nursery school, this book presents a unique approach to childhood socialization by focusing directly upon the social, interactive, and communicative processes that make up the world of young children. It contains micro-sociolinguistic analyses of videotaped peer interactive episodes which are the basis of explanations of children's development and use of social concepts such as status, role, norms, and friendship. Stable features of peer culture in the nursery school are identified, and the importance of interpreting children's behavior from their own perspective is demonstrated. The author also addresses the implications of the findings for early childhood education.

Das vorliegende Buch über Leben und Werk Martin Luthers (1483-1546) erscheint in dem Jahr, in dem sich nicht nur der Todestag des Wittenberger Reformators zum 475. Mal jährte, sondern in das auch das Datum der 500. Wiederkehr des Reichstags zu Worms fiel. In Worms hatte sich Luther einst geweigert, vor dem mächtigen Kaiser Karl V. und den Reichsständen seine Ideen, mit denen er die mächtige römisch-katholische Kirche erschüttert hatte und die evangelische Kirche begründete, zu widerrufen. Einige sehen deshalb nicht den Anschlag der 95 Thesen, sondern Luthers Verhör in Worms als das eigentliche Gründungsdatum der evangelischen Kirche an. Der Autor geht auf das Leben und das Denken Martin Luthers ein. Er erläutert dessen Theologie, die Theologie seiner Widersacher und die Veränderungen, die die Reformation für die Gesellschaft mit sich brachte. Ausführlich berücksichtigt er die einzelnen Stationen im Leben Luthers. Dabei spart er auch die Schattenseiten der Reformationszeit im Allgemeinen und Martin Luthers im Besonderen nicht aus.
